

Chapter 16

BRIDGES

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Village Council of the Village of Bellaire 7-19-1990 by Ord. No. 24A-1990. Amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 16-1. Definitions.

As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

CRAVEN DAM BRIDGE — The bridge which spans Craven Dam and is within the Village of Bellaire, and includes the abutments and sloped walls at each end of the bridge.

M-88 BRIDGE — The bridge which spans Intermediate River and is within the Village of Bellaire, and includes the abutments and sloped walls at each end of the bridge.

WARNER BRIDGE — The bridge which spans Intermediate River on West Cayuga and is within the Village of Bellaire, and includes the abutments and sloped walls at each end of the bridge.

§ 16-2. Prohibited acts.

It shall be unlawful for any person to:

- A. Jump or dive from the Craven Dam Bridge, the Warner Bridge, or the M-88 Bridge.
- B. Throw or drop any item from the Craven Dam Bridge, the Warner Bridge or the M-88 Bridge.

§ 16-3. Penalties.¹

A person who violates this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be imprisoned in the county jail no more than 90 days and/or fined no more than \$500, plus the costs of prosecution.
