

Chapter 16

BRIDGES

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Village Council of the Village of Bellaire 7-19-1990 by Ord. No. 24A-1990. Amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 16-1. Definitions.

As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

CRAVEN DAM BRIDGE — The bridge which spans Craven Dam and is within the Village of Bellaire, and includes the abutments and sloped walls at each end of the bridge.

M-88 BRIDGE — The bridge which spans Intermediate River and is within the Village of Bellaire, and includes the abutments and sloped walls at each end of the bridge.

WARNER BRIDGE — The bridge which spans Intermediate River on West Cayuga and is within the Village of Bellaire, and includes the abutments and sloped walls at each end of the bridge.

§ 16-2. Prohibited acts.

It shall be unlawful for any person to:

- A. Jump or dive from the Craven Dam Bridge, the Warner Bridge, or the M-88 Bridge.
- B. Throw or drop any item from the Craven Dam Bridge, the Warner Bridge or the M-88 Bridge, except for items directly associated with events sanctioned or authorized by the Bellaire Village Council. [Amended 07-01-2020 by Ord. No. 02 of 2020].

§ 16-3. Penalties. [Amended 07-01-2020 by Ord. No. 02 of 2020].

- A. Any person who violates any provision of this Chapter shall be responsible for a municipal civil infraction as defined in Public Act 12 of 1994, amending Public Act 236 of 1961, being Sections 600.101-600.9939 of Michigan Compiled Laws, and shall be subject to a fine of not more than Five Hundred and 00/100 (\$500.00) Dollars. Each day this Chapter is violated shall be considered as a separate violation.
- B. Officers of the Bellaire Police Department are hereby designated as the authorized village officials to issue municipal civil infraction citations directing alleged violators of this Chapter to appear in court.
