

**Bellaire Village Council  
Public Hearing Meeting Minutes  
2018-2022 Recreation Plan  
December 6, 2017**

1. **Call to Order:** President Schulz called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM and read the public hearing notice. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the adoption of the Village of Bellaire 2018-2022 Recreation Plan.

The correction was made to the plan. Another thing she questioned was the amount of full hookup sites at Craven Park that were listed in the plan. Treasurer Odom retrieved the campground map and it did show the amount of full hookup sites were listed correctly in the plan. Trustee McPherson noted that he liked the County's suggestion that we provide something with art in our parks. President Schulz noted that if we ever move forward with something like this, we would have to consider a process by which we look at allowable art as some people may find some pieces as offensive. He noted that a group in Elk Rapids has implemented a review process that seems to satisfy any concerns.

  - **Mr. Turner:** Mr. Turner asked if the park survey results were released and it was noted that they can be found on our website.
