

# VILLAGE OF BELLAIRE

## Resolution #26 of 2019

### A RESOLUTION ELECTING TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF PUBLIC ACT 152 OF 2011 BY EXERCISING THE VILLAGE'S RIGHT TO EXEMPT ITSELF FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE ACT FOR THE NEXT SUCCEEDING YEAR.

At a regular meeting of the Bellaire Village Council, Antrim County, Michigan held in the Village Hall, located at 202 N. Bridge Street, Bellaire, Michigan on November 6, 2019.

The following resolution was made by **Trustee Hardy** and seconded by **Trustee Ciganick** to-wit:

#### **Recitals**

**WHEREAS**, on September 27, 2011, the Publicly Funded Health Insurance Contribution Act, Act No. 152 of the Public Acts of Michigan of 2011 ("Act 152") became effective in the State of Michigan, and;

**WHEREAS**, Act 152 establishes standards and a process with respect to medical benefit plans offered by public employers, including the right for municipalities to exempt themselves from the expenditure limitation by a 2/3rds vote of the elected body, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Bellaire has historically recognized, in its role of steward for the public funds entrusted to it, that it must efficiently manage those limited resources, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Bellaire constantly engages in a review of expenditures in order to maximize the value it receives for goods and services, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Bellaire further believes that compensation determinations for the Village employees are most properly the responsibility of the Village's elected representatives, and not the State of Michigan or its officials.

#### **Resolution**

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that pursuant to Section 8 of Act 152, the Village of Bellaire, by at least a two-thirds vote of the Village Council, hereby exempts itself from the requirements of Act 152 for the next succeeding year, fiscal year 2020-2021;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, repealed.


